1. Hazor-hadattah, Keriath-hezron (that is, Hazor),			
2. Ummah, Aphek and Rehob—twenty-two cities with their villages.			
3. And he hanged the king of Ai on a tree until evening.			
4. Would that we had been content to dwell beyond the Jordan!			
5. The armed men were walking before the priests who were blowing the trumpets, and the rear guard was walking after the ark, while the trumpets blew continually.			
6. Now Zelophehad the son of Hopher, son of Gilead, son of Machir, son of Manasseh, had no sons, but only daughters, and these are the names of his daughters: Mahlah, Noah, Hoglah, Milcah, and Tirzah.			
7. Goshen, Holon, and Giloh: eleven cities with their villages.

10. And if it is evil in your eyes to serve the LORD, choose this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your fathers served in the region beyond the River, or the gods of the Amorites in whose land you dwell.			
11. And to the Gershonites, one of the clans of the Levites, were given out of the half-tribe of Manasseh, Golan in Bashan with its pasturelands, the city of refuge for the manslayer, and Beeshterah with its pasturelands—two cities;			
12. While the people of Israel were encamped at Gilgal, they kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month in the evening on the plains of Jericho.			
13. So your children might make our children cease to worship the LORD.			
14. Then Joshua returned, and all Israel with him, to the camp at Gilgal.			
15. And the armed men were walking before them, and the rear guard was walking after the ark of the LORD, while the trumpets blew continually.			
16. Eltolad, Chesil, Hormah,			
17. They left the city open and pursued Israel.			
18. I will be with you no more, unless you destroy the devoted things from among you.			
19. Then the LORD said to Joshua, “Stretch out the javelin that is in your hand toward Ai, for I will give it into your hand.”			
20. Then the people answered, “Far be it from us that we should forsake the LORD to serve other gods,
