Book Chapter Verse

1. And Joshua said, "Why did you bring trouble on us?"			
2. And in the hill country, Shamir, Jattir, Socoh,			
3. Moses gave an inheritance also to the tribe of Gad, to the people of Gad, according to their clans.			
4. So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the LORD had spoken to Moses.			
5. Then the boundary extends from the top of the mountain to the spring of the waters of Nephtoah, and from there to the cities of Mount Ephron.			
6. But Joshua made them that day cutters of wood and drawers of water for the congregation and for the altar of the LORD, to this day, in the place that he should choose.			
7. And allotments were made to the rest of the people of Manasseh by their clans, Abiezer, Helek, Asriel, Shechem, Hepher, and Shemida.			
8. And when they came to the region of the Jordan that is in the land of Canaan, the people of Reuben and the people of Gad and the half-tribe of Manasseh built there an altar by the Jordan, an altar of imposing size.			
9. This was the inheritance of the tribe of the people of Simeon according to their clans.			
10. Then Joshua said to Achan, "My son, give glory to the LORD God of Israel and give praise to him.			
11. Then Joshua and all Israel with him went up from Eglon to Hebron.			
12. Or if we did so to offer burnt offerings or grain offerings or peace offerings on it, may the LORD himself take vengeance.			
13. And she said, "True, the men came to me, but I did not know where they were from.			
14. And they fought against it			
15. Joshua laid an oath on them at that time, saying, "Cursed before the LORD be the man who rises up and rebuilds this city, Jericho.			
16. just as Moses the servant of the LORD had commanded the people of Israel, as it is written in the Book of the Law of Moses, "an altar of uncut stones, upon which no man has wielded an iron tool."			
17. From Sarid it goes in the other direction eastward toward the sunrise to the boundary of Chisloth-tabor.			
18. Then the boundary turns to Ramah, reaching to the fortified city of Tyre.			
19. Then the people of Reuben, the people of Gad, and the half-tribe of Manasseh said in answer to the heads of the families of Israel,			
20. And she dismounted from her donkey, and Caleb said to her, "What do you want?"
