Book Chapter Verse

1. Zenan, Hadashah, Migdal-gad,			
2. And the southern side begins at the outskirts of Kiriath-jearim.			
3. So he said to the men of Succoth, "Please give loaves of bread to the people who follow me, for they are exhausted, and I am pursuing after Zebah and Zalmunna, the kings of Midian."			
4. Remember the word that Moses the servant of the LORD commanded you, saying, 'The LORD your God is providing you a place of rest and will give you this land.'			
5. Thus there fell to Manasseh ten portions, besides the land of Gilead and Bashan, which is on the other side of the Jordan,			
6. The territory of Manasseh reached from Asher to Michmethath, which is east of Shechem.			
7. And he said to her, "Stand at the opening of the tent, and if any man comes and asks you, 'Is anyone here?'"			
8. And as they fled before Israel, while they were going down the ascent of Beth-horon, the LORD threw down large stones from heaven on them as far as Azekah, and they died.			
9. And they knew her and abused her all night until the morning.			
10. And when he drank, his spirit returned, and he revived.			
11. And they said, "There must be an inheritance for the survivors of Benjamin, that a tribe not be blotted out from Israel.			
12. Put away the gods that your fathers served beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the LORD.			
13. Now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, into the land that I am giving to them, to the people of Israel.			
14. The land of Tappuah belonged to Manasseh, but the town of Tappuah on the boundary of Manasseh belonged to the people of Ephraim.			
15. but the hill country shall be yours, for though it is a forest, you shall clear it and possess it to its farthest borders.			
16. Adoni-bezek fled, but they pursued him and caught him and cut off his thumbs and his big toes.			
17. So the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he sold them into the hand of the Philistines and into the hand of the Ammonites,			
18. Dannah, Kiriath-sannah (that is, Debir),			
19. and half Gilead, and Ashtaroth, and Edrei, the cities of the kingdom of Og in Bashan.			
20. Why did you sit still among the sheepfolds, to hear the whistling for the flocks?
