5. Then the people of Israel rose in the morning and encamped against Gibeah.			
6. From heaven the stars fought, from their courses they fought against Sisera.			
7. And the LORD drove out before us all the peoples, the Amorites who lived in the land.

13. And his mother's relatives spoke all these words on his behalf in the ears of all the leaders of Shechem, and their hearts inclined to follow Abimelech, for they said, "He is our brother."			
14. It was in the valley that belongs to Beth-rehob.			
15. Then Elon the Zebulunite died and was buried at Aijalon in the land of Zebulun.			
16. His father and mother did not know that it was from the LORD, for he was seeking an opportunity against the Philistines.			
17. And they went out into the field and gathered the grapes from their vineyards and trod them and held a festival; and they went into the house of their god and ate and drank and reviled Abimelech.			
18. When new gods were chosen, then war was in the gates.			
19. For the LORD your God dried up the waters of the Jordan for you until you passed over, as the LORD your God did to the Red Sea, which he dried up for us until we passed over,			
20. This is the inheritance of the tribe of the people of Naphtali according to their clans—the cities with their villages.
